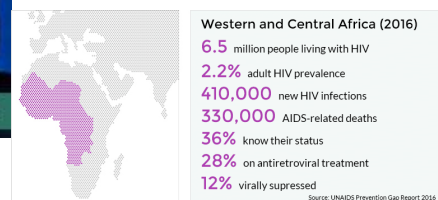

In recent years, the international community has made huge efforts to provide universal access to HIV prevention and treatment.

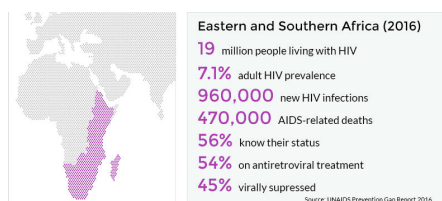

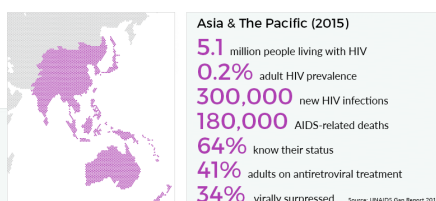

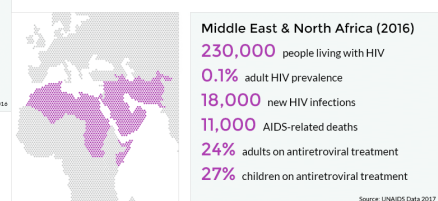

In the past decade, AIDS-related deaths have increased in the MENA region compared with a worldwide fall.

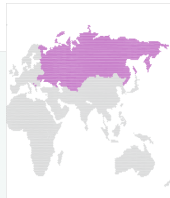

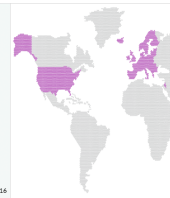
