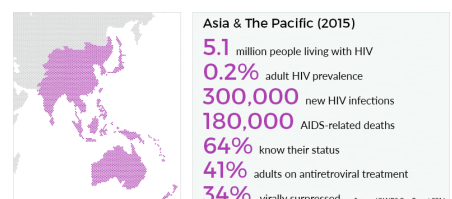

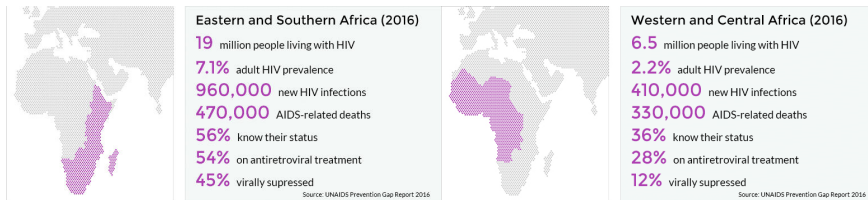
The history of HIV spans almost 100 years, since its origin in the 1920s.

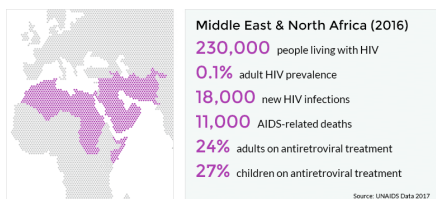

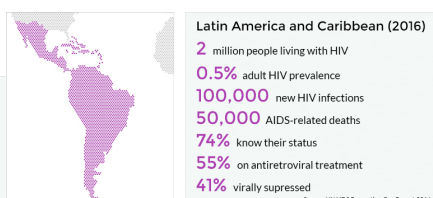

In the past decade, AIDS-related deaths have increased in the MENA region compared with a worldwide fall.

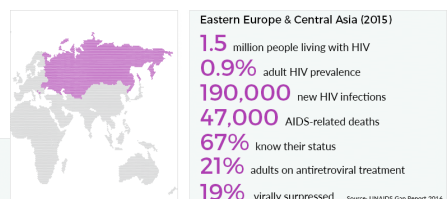

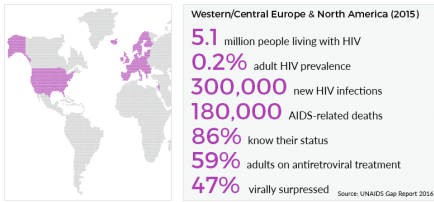
