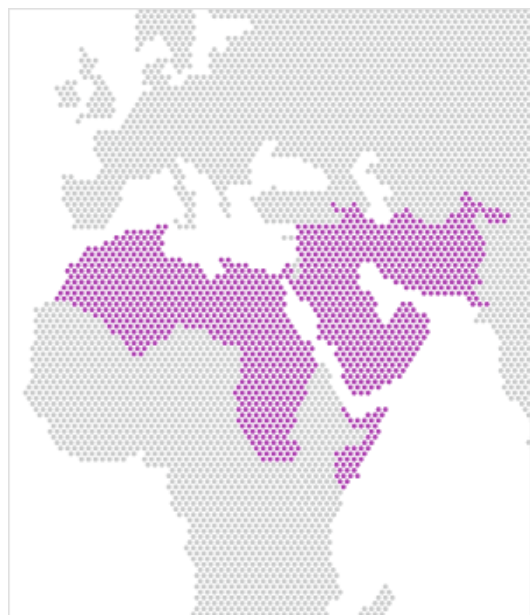


# HIV and AIDS in the Middle East and North Africa

07 August 2020

The Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region has the lowest HIV prevalence in the world (less than 0.1%) with 240,000 people recorded to be living with HIV in 2019.



## Middle East & North Africa (2018)

**240,000** people living with HIV

**<0.1%** adult HIV prevalence (ages 15-49)

**20,000** new HIV infections

**8,400** AIDS-related deaths

**32%** adults on antiretroviral treatment\*

**35%** children on antiretroviral treatment\*

\*All adults/children living with HIV
